

TOWN OF RIVERVIEW
ANNUAL MEETING APRIL 12, 2011

The meeting was called to order by Town Chairperson Ann Hogan at 7:00 P.M. on April 12, 2011. All stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes from the 2010 Annual Meeting minutes were read by Town Clerk Arnold Bubolz. There were no additions or corrections. Motion to approve by Judy Wanner and seconded by Kathleen Orchel. Unanimous consent.

2010 Financial Report:

Copies were included in the Annual Report booklet. Chairperson Hogan asked if there were any questions. Various informational questions were asked and resolved. Nels Jensen made a motion to approve, Wally Remic seconded. Unanimous consent.

Fire Department Reports:

Riverview by Don Seifert-10 calls in 2010 including two structure assists. Three practice structure burns to date in 2011.

Crooked Lake by Wally Remic-1 structure fire and 3 other calls in 2010. Constructed 38x40 Storage Building in 2010.

Ambulance Report: by Judy Wanner and Dick Booth.

175 calls in 2010. Rescue vehicle finished in 2010. New Ambulance purchased in 2010. Helicopter Pad will be installed by FOMAS in 2011.

Road Report: by Ann Hogan-

Whetter, DeGroot and Pearl were prepped for seal cost, Tar Dam from Nieman to Sullivan Springs was Pulverized and Blacktopped, and Forester was doubled Chip Seal coated.

Cemetery Report: by Dick Booth-

New Custodian will be hired.

Land Use Report: by Harlan Trosch-

The Land Use Committee consists of five members, Bob MacIntosh, President; Harlan Trosch, Vice-President; Mike Donnich, Elsie Jensen, Paal Hansen and Tawny Booth, Secretary. They meet monthly to review surveys, land divisions, and plats. They worked on longterm recreation plans and ATV routes and will be working on a Rustic Road in 2011.

Recycling Report: by Harlan Trosch.

55 gallon barrels were provided for recycling Oil Filters and Anti-freeze. Brush pickup for Crooked Lake area will be scheduled at the Recycle Center for 2011.

Animal Control Report: by Mike Rzepka-

Mike had 26 calls in 2010 for Riverview involving 1670 miles and 57 hours. Mike is certified through 2012.

Six Town Board Meetings: by Ann Hogan.

Six Northern Town Boards have been meeting jointly to address common problems and increase communications with the county. Worked on Municipal Court System in 2010.

U S Forest Service: by Ann Hogan.

Forest Service paid 50% of sign replacement costs on Maiden Lake, North Maiden Lake, Tar Dam, and Old 32 Roads. Hopefully they will be working on Loon Rapids in 2011. ATV Club will receive \$20,000 for ATV Trail from Mountain Lakes Road to Thelen Road.

A motion was made by Wally Remic and seconded by Mike Donnick to accept preceding reports. Unanimous consent.

Appointment of Banking Facilities:

Treasurer Smith stated all interest rates are low but stated working relation have been good at Wells Fargo and recommended it is in the best interest of the town to stay with Wells Fargo Bank at Mountain. A motion was made by Judy Wanner and seconded by Nels Jensen to stay with Wells Fargo. Unanimous consent.

A motion was made by Wally Remic and seconded by Kathleen Orchel to grant the Board authority to sell obsolete property with a value under \$15,000.00. Unanimous consent.

Chairperson Hogan listed the following goals completed:

- 1) Working on Ordinances.
- 2) Completed review of Fees for Town.
- 3) Completed Skating Shelters with Beaver Construction donating Labor for construction and Brunner Construction donating monies for skates. Turkey Bowl was held this past winter.

Chairperson Hogan listed the following goals for 2011:

- 1) Complete Ordinance review.
- 2) Work with Six-Towns to assure continued recycling program and promote Tourism.

Voter Requests and Desires:

T.J. Schrank requested heat for Pine Stump Recycling Center. Questions on Court System were received.

Nels Jensen made a motion to set April 10, 2012 at 7:00 P.M. as the date and time for the next Annual Meeting. Wally Remic seconded. Unanimous consent.
